We did have several outstanding performances, we had 3 individuals go 5 and 0 and two that were 4 and 4 Bradley Campbell, Lawson Fiss and Ty Haller were all undefeated Saturday. Haller had 2 very fast falls, he is a pretty big 170 pounder, this is the first time he has ever really pulled weight but man does he look good at 170. Campbell picked up 3 falls on Saturday. His Goodland match was an instant classic. Being from Burlingoton, CO Campbell has had a pretty good back and forth with the Goodland kid, Colton Cooper. It was a real tight match for the first 6 minutes, tight enough to put it into overtime. In overtime Bradley threw Cooper to his back securing the win, but ended up with a fall to boot, earning warrior of the week honors for us. Both Campbell and Haller pushed their records to 10 wins going into the break. We had 2 guys go 4 and 1 Zane Littell I think should have been 5 and 0, he picked up quite a few forfeits on Saturday, which was weird because 126 is usually a pretty loaded weight. In Littell's one loss I thought we were getting the better of the kid until we gave up what I thought was too easy of a takedown and then a fall. Livengood also suffered two pretty bad falls, he had the first takedown in both his losses, with what has become a really nice slide-by. But got thrown and pinned by a real tough Goodland kid. Then after the first takedown against Norton's State Champ, we let the kid beat us on the mat which is usually where Logan dominates. Livengood still sits at 9 and 2 both losses to state ranked kids. Weaver lost to Morales from Ulysses, I am afraid we will see him about every week. Patrick beat him last week in the finals at Ulysses, but was unable to stop Morales this week. Weaver is also 9 - 2 both losses to state ranked kids. Weaver is currently ranked #4 at 152 class 4A.
